After enjoying a meal prepared by Jim Henderson, Scott Grimm-Lyon, and Callie Fishburn, the meeting was called to order at 6:05 PM.

I. Minutes of March and May 2022 Meetings

Motion (Morse): Approve as presented. Second by Monks. Passed unanimously.

II. <u>Lake Paran Programming</u>

Presentation (attached) by Camille Kauffman of Paran Recreations. Camille Kauffman, currently VISTA for Lake Paran and soon to begin as Director of Paran Recreations, presented an overview of the facilities, resources, and programs offered at the Lake. Strong focus on outdoor recreation as well as outdoor education. Many summer camp programs and every effort made to ensure they are affordable and accessible to all. Bennington College faculty and students participate in programs.

Paran Recreations also has been cooperating with Bennington College through their Mellon Grant to focus on Food Justice. The facility's kitchen is used in the off-season to support various food access and education programs – with Bennington College, Shires Housing, Highland Hall Gardens, and others.

Paran Recreations also has worked with the BCRC and the Bennington County Conservation District on conservation initiatives. Ongoing efforts to control invasive aquatic vegetation.

Events: stone skipping competition, fireworks, polar plunge, and other community activities, plus facilities are available to be rented for private events.

Jim Henderson discussed environmental projects, existing and proposed, on Lake Paran and Paran Creek.

III. <u>Broadband Deployment in Bennington County</u>

Christine Hallquist, Director of the Vermont Community Broadband Board, discussed efforts to expand broadband coverage throughout the state. Noted challenges associated with rural nature of the state – difficult business proposition requiring public support. Covid pandemic demonstrated just how critical is internet connectivity, especially because many underserved households are low-moderate income.

Christine recognized the work of the BCRC, Southern Vermont CUD, and Consolidated Communications in making great advances in the region. \$350 million + committed to get this work done statewide; CUDs are able to access the remaining funds needed to build viable plans, often working with businesses like Consolidated.

State has stocked up on fiber to keep the process moving forward. Sheila Kearns from the SVT CUD added information about the relationship between the fiber extensions and existing cable-based services. In response to a question, discussed "starlink" satellite technology and its limitations relative to fiber.

Stacey Trudo, Sara Pelkey, and Kelly Barton presented information about Consolidated's (Fidium Fiber) work in the area (summary sheet of services and products attached). Discussed public outreach and sponsorship of community events. In response to a question, discussed plans and schedules for serving rural communities in the CUD.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:05 PM.

This dramatic shift in the character of the lake impacts not only the ecology of the lake system, but also the quality of the recreational experience for all of the boaters, swimmers, anglers, and birders that use the lake each year.

By signing this petition, we are asking municipal and state resources to allocate funding towards weed eradication in Lake Paran. We will ultimately hire a "Watershed Steward" who will further spearhead a water quality campaign around the Paran Watershed and move forward with the weed eradication permit process.
